Criteria for Registration:

- An ISP schools student between 13 and 18 years of age.
- Students need to have been enrolled for at least one full academic year in an ISP school.
- School fees need to be up to date and parents should have no debt with the school.
- Students must have good attendance and exemplary behaviour records.

How to Apply?

- Step 1:** Meet their **MUN Advisor** who will help them during the application process.
- Step 2:** Complete the **Student Application Form** and the **Parental Permission Form**. Please refer to the criteria for registration before completing the forms.
- Step 3:** Each MUN Advisor will submit all the **application forms** (Student, Parental and School) no later than **16th December 2019** to their ISP Regional Offices.
- Step 4:** Delegates will be confirmed by ISP in **early January 2020**.
